Change in circumstances

#### THE DEPARTMENT MUST BE NOTIFIED IF

- You change your address
- There is a change in your medical, financial or personal circumstances which may affect your entitlement to the allowance.
- There is a change in your or your spouse/partner's capital, savings, investments
- You, or any person included in your payment dies, leaves the country permamently or for any period, or is detained in legal custody
- You or any person included in your payment goes on a FAS course or Community Employment Scheme or commences an educational course/VTOS
- You take up employment or self employment, receive an income from any other source i.e. private pension, payment from another country, maintenance payments
- Your spouse/partner takes up employment or self employment, receives an income from any
  other source i.e. private pension, payment from another country, is awarded a pension,
  allowance or benefit in their own right, or ceases to be supported by you
- A child dependant reaches 18 years, or leaves full time education if aged between 18 and 22 years (at age 22 payment is not due beyond the end of the academic year), or becomes entitled to a Welfare payment in their own right

Failure to report any of these events may result in an overpayment which may be recoverable from you.

#### TAKING UP EMPLOYMENT

No need to submit Medical Certification after award of Disability Allowance.

Recipients of Disability Allowance, who have an entitlement to credited contributions, and who have been submitting medical certificates to Illness Benefit for award of credits, need no longer do

so. Instead Disability Allowance Section will award credits for the period of payments of the Allowance.

#### What are credited contributions?

Credited social insurance contributions (credits) are social insurance contributions that are awarded to an insured person during periods of unemployment or illness when the person cannot pay contributions. The credits protect the social insurance entitlement of the insured person during those periods any may enable him/her to qualify for various social insurance benefits. To qualify for credits the person must first have entered insurable employment i.e. she/he must have paid at least one Class A, B, C, D, E, or H PRSI contributions as an employed contributors and have paid or credited contributions in either of the last two completed income tax years. If the person has no paid or credited contributions for two consecutive years, then he/she cannot be awarded credited contributions.

Generally one credit is awarded for each week of entitlement and is usually awarded at the same rate as the person's last paid contribution.
